PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The AYBC's Summer Intensive is a two week program designed for the serious and talented students ranging in age from nine to eighteen (Junior, Intermediate and Advance Levels).

The curriculum includes Ballet Technique, Pointe, Variations, Stretch Pilates, Yoga, Modern, Musical Theatre Jazz.

Admission is by audition the 1st day of classes and students are placed in levels according to their ability. Level placement is determined by the Director. The program is limited to 50 students.

The Program will be held at the Eastern Virginia School for the Performing Arts located at 1915 Pocahontas Trail C-6 (Village Shops at Kingsmill) in an air-conditioned facility which includes three studios, all with sprung floors.

AUDITION INFORMATION

Auditions are not required, but you must have at least 3 years of ballet training . Although not required it would be helpful for new students to send along with their registration form a photograph showing a 1st arabesque, and tendu a la seconde.

TUITION

The tuition for the 2 week Summer Intensive is \$699.

A deposit of \$200 by June 1st remaining balance of \$499 by **July 1st** .

The tuition for the 1 week Summer Intensive is \$395.

A deposit of \$200 by June 1st remaining balance of \$195 by **July 1st** .

For maximum benefit 2 weeks is recommended.

Payments can be made by check to CAPA FUND or credit card (with additional 5%).

Tuition is non-refundable.
